

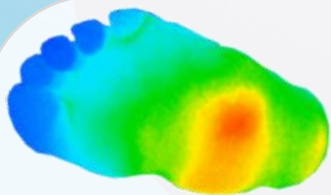


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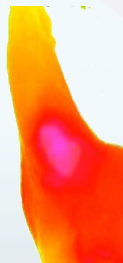

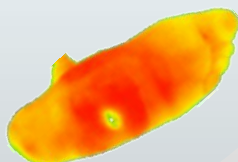
Why do Thermal Foot Assessment?



A temperature increase of 2°C can indicate infection or an episode of Charcot foot¹.



An increase in plantar foot temperature can occur up to a week before a diabetic ulcer appears².



Tissue hypoxia or vascular insufficiency may be indicated by cold areas³.
